Year 3 – Visit to Princess Christian’s Farm, TN11 9LN

As part of Year 3’s DT enquiry learning this term on grown, reared and caught, the children will be visiting Princess Christian’s Farm on Monday 29th September. Princess Christian’s Farm is a working farm set on over 116 acres of woodland and pasture. The children will be given a full tour of the farm, meeting its many animals along the way. These range from small animals like rabbits and mice, to larger animals such as sheep, ponies and alpacas. There is also an area dedicated to reptiles. It will be a full and fun morning or afternoon, aiming to spark lots of interest and discussion.

The children will be leaving school in two groups. 3SW will leave at 9.30am and will return by lunchtime and 3AS will leave at 12.20 and return by the end of the school day. They will be travelling by coach and will be wearing a seat belt in accordance with current legalisation.

Lunches:

Due to the timings on the day, please could **ALL** children bring a **PACKED LUNCH** to eat at school either before they go (3AS) or when they return (3SW).

Please could we ask that children are not sent in with any pocket money as there will be no opportunities to spend it on the day.

On the day:

Children should wear school uniform, wellington boots and take a warm waterproof coat.
