Year 6 – Visit to the Houses of Parliament

As part of our history learning about Ancient Greece and democracy, Year 6 are fortunate to have booked a visit to the Houses of Parliament in Westminster. We will be receiving a talk and then have a guided tour of the Palace of Westminster

The children will be visiting on the following days:

6AH – Monday 29th September

6OP – Wednesday 1st October

The children will leave after registration and catch the train from Tonbridge to London Charing Cross. They will be back by the end of the school day.

WHAT TO BRING:

In order to be more environmentally friendly and reduce plastic waste, we encourage you to provide your child with a packed lunch, water bottle and a snack (no nuts, kiwi fruit, or fizzy drinks), in a small backpack. Please could we ask that children are NOT sent in with any pocket money or electronic devices.

WHAT TO WEAR:

Children should wear school uniform and black school shoes (no trainers) and they will need a warm waterproof coat.
