Progression in Skill:

Use accurate pronunciation so that others understand, self-correcting as necessary.

Use cognates and context clues to work out unfamiliar words.

Understand and use the definitive article correctly: le/la/l'/les.

Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures

Understand basic grammar appropriate to the language being studied, including feminine and masculine forms.
