Dear Parents

Year 5 - London Central Mosque – Tuesday 3rd March 2026

As part of our Year 4 enquiry learning about the Golden Age of Islam in History and the Pillars of Islam in RE, Year 5 will be visiting the London Central Mosque on Tuesday 3rd March 2026.

Children will be leaving school at 9.30am and will return to school by 3.45pm. They will be travelling by train and the Underground. Due to the timings, please make sure you have notified any clubs your child attends of the late return.

Please could we ask that children are not sent in with any pocket money as there will be opportunities to spend it on the day.

On the day:

In order to be more environmentally friendly and reduce plastic waste, we encourage you to provide your child with a substantial packed lunch (half of which they will eat on the train there) and a drink (no nuts, kiwi fruit, or fizzy drinks), in a small backpack. Please ensure there is NO PORK in the packed lunches.

Payment:

The cost of this trip will be £8.75 per child. Payments can be made through Arbor under TRIPS – Year 5 London Central Mosque. If you experience any difficulty, please contact the school office. All payments should be made by Friday 27th February at the latest.

Helpers:

We would love some helpers for the trip so if you would like to express an interest in helping, please sign up via Arbor – TRIPS - HELPERS ONLY Mosque. You will be notified by the teacher whether your help is required on this trip, once the timetables have been finalised. Please **DO NOT** assume by booking a place you are a helper. We would appreciate all offers of help by Monday 2nd February.

PLEASE BE AWARE OF STRICT MODEST DRESS CODE FOR ADULTS:

Please do not wear skirts, tights, leggings, tight trousers, ripped jeans or shorts – these do not comply.

A head scarf is required for the females (a few scarves might be available upon arrival, if requested).

The dress code does not apply to children of primary school age however, **tights** would be appreciated as we will be visiting the main prayer hall.
