Essential Prior Learning:

Give opinions about what you do and don't like, e.g. *Je aime ... Je déteste ...*
Name some common leisure activities.
Use *parce que* to explain why.
Name the days of the week.
Name some foods you do and don't like.
Name some areas of the school curriculum.

Progression in Skill:

Talk about the sports that you do and why, giving an opinion.
Use the definitive article with sports.
Use the conjunctions *et* and *mais*.
Devise and ask questions.
Present information.
Show an understanding of the conversation through appropriate responses.
Understand longer texts that use known language in new contexts.
Write longer texts that use known language in new contexts.

Long-term Memory Knowledge:

Name some common sports.
Use the definitive article when talking about the sports they do and don't do.
Construct longer sentences using *mais, et* and *parce que* in speaking and writing.
Respond appropriately to the question *Tu aime quels sports?*

Relevance
