Dear Parents,

Year 5 Visit to the Science Museum – Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June

As part of next term's enquiry entitled "Has the time come to trust machines over humans?" we will be visiting the Science Museum in London to investigate forces.

The trip will take place on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June. We will be travelling to the Science Museum by train and underground. Once there, we will be completing a number of different activities, some of which are guided by museum staff and others, which are self-led.

Timings

On the day of the trip, the children should arrive at school by **8.20am** and we will be returning to school by **4.00pm**, so please ensure you have informed any clubs your child attends of the late return.

What to bring

Children will need a snack and a packed lunch (no nuts or kiwi fruit) as well as a refillable bottle of water (no fizzy drinks). Children are welcome to bring a small deck of cards or a few coloured pencils on the train. We will supply the paper. Please could we ask that children do not bring money or electronic games.

What to wear

As we will be doing a lot of walking, children may wear trainers but other than that will need to wear normal school uniform. They will need a raincoat/sunhat depending on the weather on the day.

Payment

We are enormously grateful to the SRSA who are funding this trip and therefore there is **no cost** to parents for the Science Museum workshops or travel. We will still require parents to give **CONSENT** for this trip, so please sign your child up via Arbor – trips – Science Museum. All responses should be made by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June.
