Dear Parents

Year 3 – Visit to Sheffield Park, Uckfield, East Sussex

As part of Year 3's exploration of impressionism art in term 6, the children will be visiting Sheffield Park on **Tuesday 7th July**. The children will have the opportunity to observe and paint the water lilies, drawing inspiration from the impressionist artist Claude Monet and his Water Lilies series.

The children will be leaving school at 9.15am and will return by the end of the school day. They will be travelling by coach and will be wearing a seat belt in accordance with current legalisation.

Please could we ask that children are not sent in with any pocket money as there will be no opportunities to spend it on the day.

On the day:

In order to be more environmentally friendly and reduce plastic waste we encourage you to provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink (no nuts, kiwi fruit, or fizzy drinks) in a small backpack. Children should wear school uniform and trainers and take either a warm waterproof coat or sunhat/sun cream depending on the weather. They will also need an old T-shirt or apron and a plastic bag to sit on while they paint.
