#### National Curriculum Links:

Use technology purposely to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

#### Essential Prior Learning:

Children will have seen adults use computers to teach from in school. Children will have opened applications on their parents' phones, iPads, televisions etc.

#### Progression in Skill:

Use digital technology to store and retrieve content  
Create original content using digital technology

#### Long-term Memory Knowledge:

A document can be saved on a computer and opened again. It can be changed and saved to use another time.

#### Key Vocabulary

<b>store</b>	save digital content on the computer so it can be opened again
<b>retrieve</b>	open digital content
<b>digital content</b>	a piece of work on the computer
<b>document</b>	usually some writing or an image

#### Relevance

<b>Now</b>	Children understand that they can keep documents saved on the computer/iPad and then come back and see/change them again at another time – they do not have to complete something all at once.
<b>Future</b>	Computers and other digital technology will be used successfully to create, store and edit a range of documents that make professional and personal life easier.
<b>Aspiration</b>	An interest in computers and digital technology could lead children to pursue a career as a computer engineering, developing the products of the future; they may become system analysts – identifying computing wants and needs for particular businesses and supporting programmers in accommodating these.
