## Year 3 – Visit to the Canterbury Roman Museum and The Beaney Museum

As part of our Term 4 topic on the Romans, Year 3 are going to visit the Canterbury Roman Museum and The Beaney Museum on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> February. On our visit we will find out about Roman technology, handle Roman artefacts and see an actual Roman hypocaust and mosaic. It will also give the children an opportunity to visit the lovely Roman town by train.

#### **PAYMENT**:

A huge thank you to the SRSA who have heavily subsidised this trip, reducing the cost for parents from £17.00 to only £5.00 per child including transport. Payments can be made through Arbor – please look under Trips – Year 3 Canterbury Museum. Please could all payments be made by Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February at the latest.

#### TIMINGS:

On the day of the trip, the children should arrive at school at **8.30am promptly** for an 8.45am departure from school. **The return time will be 5.00pm**. We will be travelling by train. Please ensure you have notified any after school club your child attends of the late return.

## **WHAT TO BRING:**

In order to be more environmentally friendly and reduce plastic waste, we encourage you to provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink (no nuts, kiwi fruit, or fizzy drinks), in a small backpack. They should also bring an extra bottle of water and fruit/vegetable snack to consume on the train to/from Canterbury. Children are welcome to bring a deck of cards or a few coloured pencils/crayons/felt tips on the train - we will supply paper. Please could we ask that children are NOT sent in with any pocket money or electronic devices.

### WHAT TO WEAR:

Children should wear school uniform and black school shoes (no trainers) and they will need a warm waterproof coat.
