Bikeability – Year 6 (current Year 5 pupils)

We have been invited to book 30 places for Year 6 (current Year 5 pupils) for Bikeability in 2023/2024 term 6. Whilst it would be lovely to offer this to every child in Year 6, we know that not everyone will be in a position to take part, as the course expects children to already be able to ride their bike. The course is not designed to teach children how to ride a bike. Every child must have a road worthy bike and a cycling helmet that is certified to the European Standard (EN1078), or preferably certified to Snell B95 standard.

Before we are able to book Bikeability sessions with Kent County Council, we need to see how many children would be interested in taking part. Could I therefore ask you complete the following electronic form by Thursday 1st June 10.00am so we can see what level of interest we have. This is a very tight turnaround in order for us to secure the best sessions for that term.

Kent County Council Bikeability:

Bikeability cycle training equips children with vital life skills. Pupils not only learn to cycle, they also gain independence, social skills and a sense of wellbeing.

After Bikeability, children are better at responding to risk and report increased confidence. As a result, more children cycle to school, which in turn improves mental health and wellbeing. This allows children to get more out of the classroom, improving their attention span and engagement. Healthier habits lead to increased attendance and improved academic results. Bikeability goes beyond a training course; it impacts children's lives.
